

#### Odyssey 6.4.2

The fall release of the latest version of Odyssey has arrived. Full of enhancements across all modules, Odyssey 6.4.2 will have something for everyone. From Accounts Payable to Tool Management, we added over 50 enhancements and 70 stability and performance improvements. With an emphasis on ensuring your good ideas are in Odyssey,

16 enhancements were added directly from the customer feedback forum.

Over the years, there have been several community requests to add Urgent Notes in various areas of the system. In 6.4.1, we added Urgent Notes to Customers that display when adding Cash Receipts for that customer, to Products when doing an internal hold or RMA for that product, and to Shop Order Routings when reporting production against that routing step. In 6.4.2, we finished the Urgent Note project by adding Urgent Notes to Materials that will display when issuing that material. The Supplier screen has a new Urgent Note when doing outside receipts from that supplier. When receiving material against a particular purchase order item, a new Urgent Note can be added to the purchase order item to display. The Customer screen has two new Urgent Notes. One will display when creating a quote for a customer and another when doing an RFQ for a customer.

Another big highlight of Odyssey 6.4.2 is to create new Data Views, Dashboards, or Multi-Views from a stock set of views provided by B&L. In Data Explorer or the Dashboard Designer, you can use the new Add from System Data View or Add from System Dashboard to copy the stock view into your company. You can then review and modify the Data View or Dashboard to suit your needs. These Data Views and Dashboards are not only a starting point for your new views but also demonstrate some of the advanced capabilities of Data Explorer. When 6.4.3 comes out in the first quarter of 2023, look for more stock dashboards and multi-views to be added.

Ever wonder who and when a Data View or a report was last run? Run statistics have been added to Data Explorer, Dashboards, and reports. These statistics show who last ran the report or view, when they last did it, and how many times the report or view has been run.

Surcharges can fluctuate, and to help ensure invoices to your customers reflect current rates, you can use a new "Recalculate Surcharge" option from the Accrued Charge History screen. Before creating invoices, you can use this option to recalculate surcharges that might have changed since they were accrued.

The Product Demand Analysis screen is one of Odyssey's more powerful and useful screens. However, the Parent Demand column did not include demand from customer orders that did not have shop orders. This would exclude make-to-stock items from being included in parent demand. In Odyssey 6.4.2, the Parent Demand column of the Product Demand Analysis screen will now include demand from these customer orders for make-to-stock parts.

When receiving material short against a purchase order and manually completing the release, the purchase order's order quantity is now adjusted to reflect the actual on-order quantity. This ensures the visibility of what is on order is not over-stated due to short-received material.

Do you need multiple versions of Shop Cards displayed from the Shop Floor Manager? Maybe you need two versions of your shop cards — one in English and one in Spanish. When designing a Shop Floor Manager screen, you can specify a different shop card report. This new feature is also available for Tool Shop Cards and Process Sheets.

A new flag has been added to the Customer screen to identify how shipments are considered on time. This new flag, "Considered Late", can be checked if partial shipments will always be considered late if the entire shipment does not ship on time.

These are only a handful of the many enhancements released in Odyssey version 6.4.2. To see all the enhancements and stability improvements, visit Rapid Support. If you are already running Odyssey 6.4.2, the release documentation is available from the left sidebar.

Although planning for Odyssey 6.4.3 is nearly complete, we are still reviewing feedback enhancements each month. If you have ideas to improve Odyssey to help you run your business and add value to metalcasters, please visit Odyssey's customer feedback forum.
