

Integrations with Odyssey

Integrating third-party systems with Odyssey is not a mysterious concept. At its most basic, integration simply passes data back and forth between two systems through a flat file. The most advanced integrations are automatic and seamless, allowing all forms of information to flow freely through a stream of data. Odyssey was not architected

as an open system to allow all data to be liberally passed around between external applications. It was designed to be an internal, tightly integrated ERP system where its modules use and share data to help run your business effectively and efficiently.

Although the Odyssey database and system architecture focuses on the user interface, Odyssey has supported integration for many years. The Import Wizard and Export Wizard were modules added very early in Odyssey's life cycle. Although they use flat file CSV or XML documents to transfer data, there is nothing basic about their implementation. Imports can be added to a scheduled job or run on-demand through a PowerShell script. They leverage the same business logic validation and updates that the Odyssey user interface uses. This ensures the integrity of the data you import into Odyssey. Exports can also be scheduled to run on a regular basis or manually run on demand. Exports can dump data directly from an Odyssey table, or you can leverage the power of Odyssey's Intelligent Views module to use a Data View as the data source of your integration.

Modern integrations are seamless connections between two systems, meaning data flows directly from one system to another. Odyssey has an API that supports this integration. Our API has many endpoints that allow you to pull data out of Odyssey using a pre-defined export, FetchData endpoints that leverage the power of the Progress Advanced Business Language, or endpoints that allow you to use Progress' SQL-compliant connection. We have built a production interface to push data into Odyssey to help you report production from machines or other systems. There are also a set of Record endpoints that allow you to write data into Odyssey using the update and validation business objects that its user interface uses.

APIs are the modern, best-practice way of integrating data between two systems. Although Odyssey has an API to support seamless integrations, we need to maintain tight control of the flow of the data. This ensures that your system will continue to run smoothly, and your data stays valid. When you start the process of architecting an integration, don't start with the how. Start with the why and the what. Odyssey has many ways of integrating with other systems, but you must first have a clear understanding of what you are going to integrate and why you need to integrate. Develop and understand the business needs first, and then B&L can help you choose the right integration tool to meet your needs. A sophisticated, fully integrated API coded with the latest programming methodologies might be the right solution, but it could be a simple flat-file exchange of data that will meet your needs.
